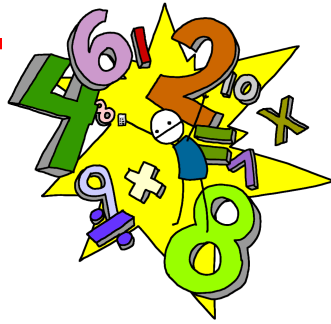


Maths

This half term the children will be learning about:

- The four operations

English

Year One will be using their phonics to complete Read, Write Inc writing tasks. This allows the children to build vocabulary, spelling and fluency to get them off to a good start with writing. Our SPaG focus will be capital letters and full stops, writing simple sentences correctly.



Computing

Year One will cover the 'We are collectors' module through Switched On computing. They will learn what algorithms are and practise creating them. Within E-Safety, they will learn about keeping personal information private.

The Gunpowder Plot.

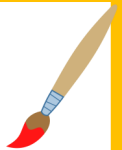
Science
