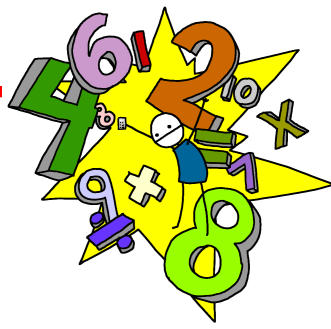


## Maths

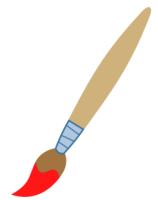
## History
